

Balkans Peace Park Project Committee Members

Whilst giving their time, services, expert advice and expenses voluntarily and free of charge, the Committee is almost entirely composed of professionals, including two university professors (one a founder member of the world's largest Peace Studies university Department), two college lecturers, two academic researchers (one an internationally acknowledged anthropological authority on South East Europe), a freelance editor affiliated with Cambridge University (thus, six of the Committee Members have university affiliations), a former government advisor on biking as a means of transportation who is also a trustee of a major charity, three lawyers (one an immigration judge, another a corporate financial advisor), and a freelance writer on mountaineering and related issues. Whilst the group is voluntary it is not amateur, and brings in related professional and regional experts, for their consultation at most meetings. The Committee currently employs a part-time IT consultant/website designer.
